Barra Brui: Hunter Ave, St Ives. The driveway to the hall is on your right a few hundred metres after you turn into Hunter Ave. There's a locked gate at the top.

Tasks involve simply mowing and whipper-snipping the grass around the Barra Brui Activities Hall. You need to bring your own tools. Please note that there are two halls at this location. We only need to maintain the grounds of the hall at the very end of the driveway.

West Epping: 12 Willoughby St, Epping. The front and back yards need mowing, and areas around the hall and driveway can be maintained with a whipper-snipper. Crews need to bring their own equipment.
