Joey Scout Uniform and Badge Placement

QRG 08

The official Joey Scout uniform is in line with the National Uniform of the Association and comprises of the following compulsory items:

1. Blue shirt with tan collar, yoke and sleeve stripes.
2. Scarf
3. Blue web belt

Optional items:

1. Trousers/shorts – official uniform is beige/stone/light grey colour.
2. Headwear – refer to your Scout Group/Region. Joey Scouts must wear a hat for all outdoor activities.

Badges:

Joey Scouts are able to wear the Challenge Badges and special event badges on their shirts in the position set out by National guidelines.

Some badges are “blanket badges” and are not to be worn on the uniform. Please check with your RC JS for advice about specific badges. Some Mobs encourage Joey Scouts to wear these other badges on the hat flap. Encourage Joey Scouts to start a Campfire Blanket.

The Promise Challenge Badge may be worn on the Cub Uniform until receipt of the Bronze Boomerang.

Walkabout and Camper badges are carried through to be worn on cub uniform.

Cub Scout Link Badge may be worn on the Cub uniform, and transferred to the Scout uniform with the addition of the Scout Link Badge. Similar with advancement to Ventures and Rovers until all Link Badges are worn in a row.

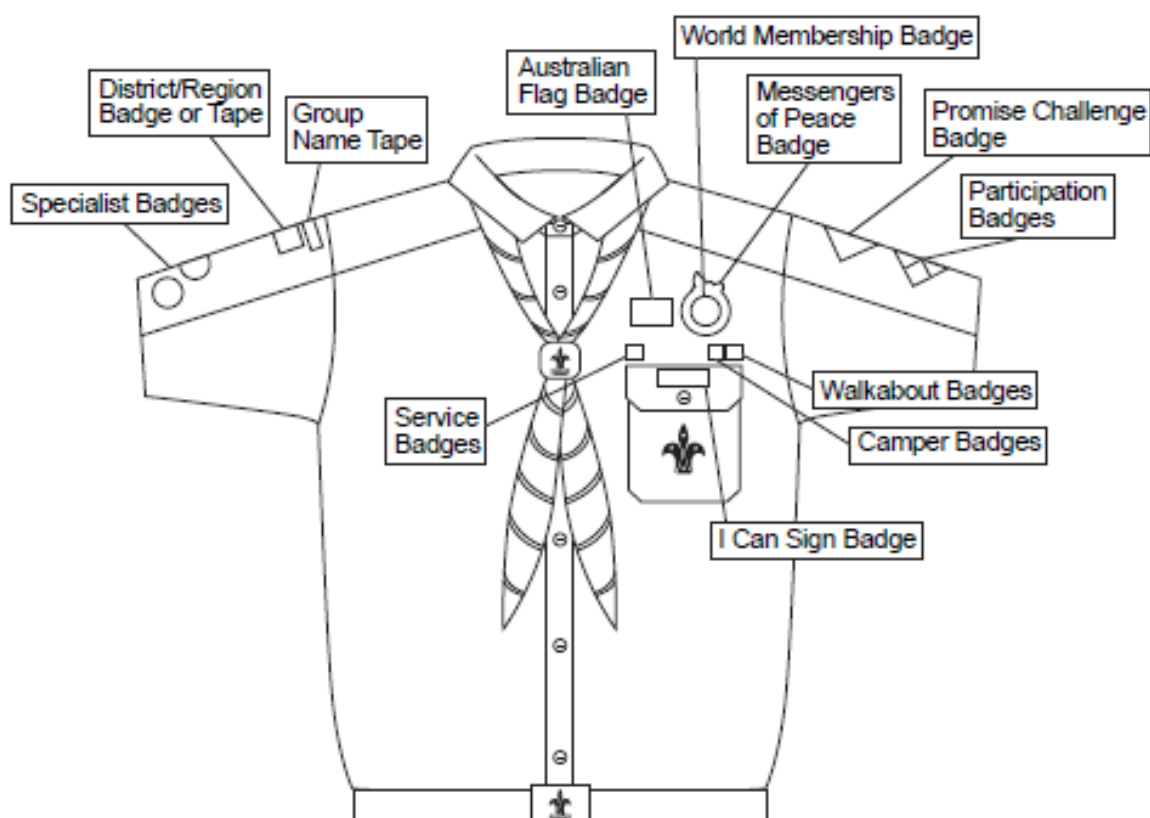
Note: from February 2017, Challenge Badges and Promise Challenge Badge are to be worn on the left sleeve. Refer to current diagram on next page.

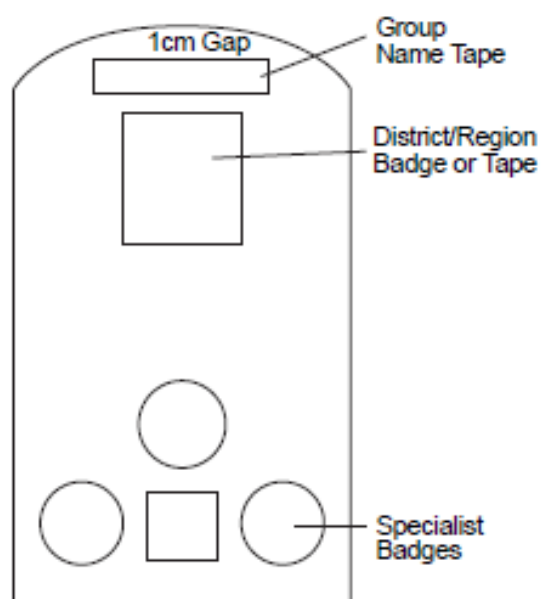
