This badge is NOT a mandatory requirement for advancement up to the Cub Scout Section. It is only to be awarded if ALL of the requirements have been met.

The JSL should meet with the parent and explain the entire process and try to remove any possible uncertainty. If they are unavailable the night your cub pack meets, are there other cub packs nearby on a different night. Have this information prepared before you speak to the parent.

Attached is the checklist for linking to cubs. Most of the items need to be signed off by the Cub Scout Leader and then the final item by the Joey Scout Leader.

Who presents the Link Badge?

The Ceremonies Book says it shall be awarded by the Joey Scout Leader, Group Leader or nominated person. The “nominated person” can be any leader, including the Cub Scout Leader.

The important part is that the badge is awarded in front of the Joey Scout Mob, so it can inspire them to do the same.
